

IASD Board Meeting – Membership Meeting
Friday, June 23th, 2005
2006 Conference – Bridgewater, MA

Preceding the Board Meeting, outgoing President, Wendy Pannier commented on her experience over the last year and thanked those who had helped during this time. This was followed by opening remarks by incoming President Jean Campbell. Jean stated that she will be giving special emphasis to building bridges between members, members and the board, and IASD and the larger community. Jean also gave special recognition to May Tong, IASD member and very active in IASD work, who passed away shortly before the conference.

Jean asked the membership to talk among themselves about ways to improve IASD. Following these discussions, members were asked to share with the group their ideas. These included: extend more internationally (i.e. through an online associates program); create directory of members so that members can get in touch with each other for statewide and regional get-togethers; IASD should reach out to other likeminded groups; check for links to Hollywood and business; bring IASD to festivals, gatherings; spread IASD through local dream groups; look at the connection between creativity in the arts and dreams; we have to make sure that we reach students to make presentations at IASD.

Minutes of last Membership Meeting – The membership accepted the minutes from the last Membership meeting held at last year’s conference. Curt Hoffman moved that the minutes be approved as submitted. Motion seconded by Rita Dwyer. Membership approved.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Robert Waggoner gave highlights from his report and thanked the membership for its support. He noted that: IASD now has its first full-time employee (Richard Wilkerson in the Central Office) and has a part-time managing editor for IASD-News, Jacque Lewis. In 2005 the total revenue was \$205,704 with total expenses equaling \$176,329.

Current and Future Conferences – Jean Campbell gave special thanks to this year's conference host Curt Hoffman. Curt in turn thanked all the attendees, university staff, and IASD volunteers for their work. Curt reported that there were 265 registered attendees at the conference. Executive Officer Bob Hoss thanked Bridgewater State University for hosting this year's conference.

Board member and next year's conference host, Laurel McCabe presented highlights of next year's venue (new accommodations; rooms in suite arrangement; pre-conference workshops; beautiful setting; a nearby art preserve.

Dream Science Foundation – Bob Hoss gave an introduction to the newly created Dream Science Foundation. This foundation was created to provide seed money for studies of dreams and dreaming. It will award grants of \$5,000 each year. IASD will set up a grant review committee to evaluate letters of intent and proposals. The current committee includes: David Kahn, Roger Knudson, Ernest Hartmann, Mark Blagrove, Stan Krippner, and Bob Van de Castle. The foundation will be soliciting letters of interest and proposals this year.

2006 Student Awards – Roger Knudson, committee chair, provided an introduction to the student awards program to the membership. The awards program is open to all students and submissions are placed into two major categories: original research and creative work.

Sheila Asato won \$500 and an IASD Plaque for her work on *The Design of Dreams: How the Healing Collage Process Relates to Dreaming*. Lana Nasser also won \$500 and an IASD Plaque for her paper, *Creative Interpretation of a Dream*. An honorable mention IASD Award Certificate was given to Marlene Cantor for her investigation of *Menopausal Women and Their Dreams*.

Shirley McClaine Contest – Shirley McClaine included a contest on her website offering a free conference registration from IASD. More than 800 people entered the

contest and the winner was Kathleen Monahan. She could not make this year's conference but will be attending next year's.
